RESPONSIBILITIES/TASKS (include but are not limited to)

- Escorting patients to/from various places.
- Assisting with activities and engaging with patients as they progress through their recovery
- Assisting counselors and therapeutic team.
- Documenting relevant information regarding the patient's activities.
- Observe urine screen as needed.
- Responsible for hourly room checks and property searches
- Any other therapeutic assistance as needed
